The 2022-23 budget hearing of the Village of Duncan Board of Trustees and budget amendment hearing for 2021-2022 was opened at 7:03 PM by Chairperson Jeff Oppliger. The Chairperson publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review and indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was held in the Village Hall. Board members present were Nick Wagoner, Steve Langton, Jeff Oppliger, Josh Dahlberg and Joe Boruch. Also, in attendance were, Village Staff: Don Reves, Marianna Evans and Michelle Schindel. Visitors present were: Ryan Gray (Columbus Chief Firefighter); Gary Schlesinger. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all in attendance. Oppliger asked if there were any questions or concerns about the 2022-2023 budget that was available to review. Evans reminded the board that the amendment to the last year's budget was needed due to the street project billing. The final invoice for the street project that year was received and paid after the end of the 2020-21 budget year. It was paid during the 2021-22 budget year instead. She reminded the board that the \$345k was the amount of the final payment. This amount was previously approved for the 2020-21 budget, but paid at the beginning of the 2021-22 budget year. No concerns/questions were announced. A motion to close the public hearings for the 2022-23 budget and amended 2021-22 budget was made by Oppliger, second—Dahlberg. Vote was as follows: voting aye—Wagoner, Langton, Oppliger, Dahlberg & Boruch. Voting nay—none. The Chairman carried the motion. A motion to approve the 2022-23 budget along with the amended 2021-22 budget was made by Wagoner, second—Boruch. Vote was as follows: voting aye—Wagoner, Langton, Oppliger, Dahlberg & Boruch. Voting nay— The Chairman carried the motion. Evans reads R22-260 aloud in full. A motion to pass R22-260 Adopt 2022-'23 Budget was made by Wagoner, second—Boruch. voting aye—Wagoner, Langton, Oppliger, Dahlberg & Boruch. Voting nay—none. The Chairman carried the motion. Evans reads R22-265 aloud Amend 2021-22 Budget. A motion to pass R22-265 Amend 2021-22 Budget was made by Boruch, second—Dahlberg, voting aye—Wagoner, Langton, *Oppliger, Dahlberg & Boruch. Voting nay—none. The Chairman carried the motion.* Evans reads R22-261 Property Tax Set 2022-23. A motion to pass R22-261 was made Wagoner, second—Boruch. voting aye—Wagoner, Langton, Oppliger, Dahlberg & Boruch. Voting nay—none. The Chairman carried the motion. Oppliger reports that the Village will need to approve the 1% additional increase of the total restricted funds (subject to limitation) as in past years. No questions or concerns were announced. A motion to approve the additional 1% increase of the total 2021-2022 restricted funds (subject to limitation) was made by Dahlberg, second—Wagoner. voting aye—Wagoner, Langton, Oppliger, Dahlberg & Boruch. Voting nay—none. The Chairman carried the motion.

All meetings are open to the public and a current agenda for said meetings will be posted and available for public inspection at the office of the Village Clerk, Post Office, TBone 2 and the Village website on the Thursday prior to the meeting.
