The title of the pilgrimage is: <u>The Saints of Italy Pilgrimage</u>
We will start the pilgrimage by spending five full days in



Rome. We will then head to San Giovanni Rotondo, Italy for two days to visit the Shrine of St. Padre Pio. We will also visit a nearby shrine where St. Michael the Archangel appeared in the year 490 A.D. to the local bishop. Every year thousands of pilgrims visit this Shrine, which is called The Sanctuary of St. Michael

Finally, we will spend two days in Assisi, Italy, the home of Saint Francis and Saint Clare of Assisi.
